The proposed Ordinance will amend the Sex Offender Registration Code (SORC) Article 1. Sex Offender Registration, in its entirety; and the Children's Code, Chapter 1. General Provisions, with respect to the handling of juvenile records. The amendments are proposed to comply with the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA), Title I of Public Law 109-248 on the CRIT Reservation and the Office of Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering, and Tracking (SMART) requirements. The amendments will take effect upon their enactment.

Written comments from the public will be accepted at the address below up until 5:00 p.m. on the day of the hearing. Any comments submitted will be made a part of the SORC legislative record and will be considered for incorporation into the final Code. Submit comments to:
