DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The position is an administrative function in the Government of the Colorado River Indian Tribes. Reporting to the Chairman of the Colorado River Indian Tribes, the incumbent is responsible for directing all environmental quality projects and activities. Duties of the Director include coordinating the design and implementation of programs designed to maintain and improve the quality of the environment in the area of the land, water, solid waste, chemicals, endangered species and air quality. Additionally, the director establishes departmental policies, goals, and strategies to resolve managerial concerns, development of proposals, budgets, schedules, plans, policies and procedures for the Department of Environmental Protection Office, and assures the establishment of a system of staff development including evaluation and individual training plans. Also, establishes procedures to evaluate the effectiveness of the Department of Environmental Protection programs and projects, including submittal of quarterly and annual reports of operational performances to other agencies that provide funding for the environmental programs as well as Tribal committees. Coordinates with federal, state, tribal and local agencies on investigations and response to hazardous material incidents and all environmental activities. Performs other duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS:

Must possess a Bachelor Degree in Biology, Environmental Science or related field or an equivalent of five (5) years of concurrent professional and administrative experience in a related field. Must possess a valid Driver's License. Knowledge, skills and abilities must be directly related to preceding five (5) years. Must have knowledge and ability to

communicate and work with all industrial, agricultural, Tribal enterprises and local community. Thorough knowledge of environmental regulations, EPA Tribal Policy, and considerable knowledge of agricultural industry, educational health, and social and cultural needs of Native Americans.
