### VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

#### PRIMARY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assist the monitoring of wells - Log water and electrical meters for water production and electrical usage. Keep area clean.
2. Works with co-workers on maintenance; flushing hydrants, valve exercising, new connects to system, repairs to any system if needed, road patches, storage repairs and maintenance.
3. Assist with monitoring of pumps - Log electric usage, maintenance pressure at 120 psi, grease and secure packing, alternate pumps, maintain proper oil levels in air compressors and motors. Keep all on record. Keep area clean and maintained.
4. Assist with monitoring of chemicals - log usage of chlorine and aquadene (NPACO 216) daily. Place gallon retainers to auxiliary station barrel. Clean injectors and maintain proper speed and stroke on pump meters. Exchange chlorine bottles when empty, disconnect and reconnect bottles to regulator, change filters to keep injectors and solenoids flowing.
5. Assist with the weekly and monthly records of water usage and chemical used to assure correct amounts of chlorine and aquadene are being injected.
6. Assist with the monthly readings on commercial meters, tabulate correct gallons and apply to rate costs for billing
7. Assist in collecting samples from the water system.
8. Excavate for water main installations or repairs, braces trenches, lays pipe, fills in ditches, operates and maintains pumping facilities.
9. Performs maintenance on pumps and motors
10. Operates, maintains and repairs in ground sprinkler system.

11. Perform routine maintenance and equipment safety checks.
12. Answers emergency calls from the public and other agencies, takes appropriate action such as place barricades, removing fallen trees, and limbs, emergency patching of streets, and repairing water lines.
13. May perform weekend pump rounds and other assigned tasks.
14. Ability to learn new tasks and procedures
15. Able to work independently and as a team player.

**EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must have a high School Diploma or GED
2. Must have valid driver's license, a satisfactory driving record, and reliable transportation
3. Have a basic working knowledge of common tools and equipment used in construction maintenance work, basic safety precautions and procedures.
4. Water Operator Certifications preferred or must be able to pass certification tests to become certified Water Operator.
5. Understand and follow verbal and written instructions; works safely and effectively; deal tactfully with the public.
6. Ability to work on assigned tasks without supervision.

**PHYSICAL REQUIREMENT:**

1. Ability to perform strenuous tasks, often for extended periods and/or adverse Climatic conditions.
2. Works safely and effectively and deals tactfully with the public, customers and other employees
3. Appropriate dress attire for the job is required.
