SUMMARY:

This individual will be based out of the Bruce Church shop and also operate a mobile service vehicle and travel to all field locations to perform in-field, machinery diagnostics and repairs as required. These repairs will consist of, but are not limited to, complete component removal, disassembly, and reconditioning, following prescribed technical manual procedures. This individual must be able to perform quality work as efficiently as possible to return equipment to the field and not delay production, work long hours and weekends on occasion. This position will be on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

SPECIFIC DUTIES INCLUDE:

- Perform in-field machinery diagnostics and repairs as required.
- Diagnose, inspect, recondition, repair, assemble, and service equipment as assigned by the Shop Manager.
- Document machine information and repairs completed on work order, including parts and fluids used.
