<p>WHAT'S BEING PLANNED</p>	<p>The California Department of Transportation, in cooperation with Federal Highway Administration and the Arizona Department of Transportation, proposes construction of a bridge replacement located on the State Route-62 (SR-62) in San Bernardino County and State Route-95 Spur (SR-95S1) in La Paz County. The purpose of this project is to resolve the existing bridge's decreased structural integrity, maintain a safe movement of vehicular traffic, and improve people and goods movement. The proposal consists of constructing a non-increasing capacity project to replace or widen/rehabilitate the existing Colorado River Bridge.</p>
