

Colorado River Indian Tribes Reservation 911 House Numbering Systems

INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

The Colorado River Indian Tribes in conjunction with La Paz County Community Development Office, realizing the need for a comprehensive addressing system, appointed an addressing system.

The numbering (911) system will make it possible for fire, police, ambulance and public utility companies to locate residences and properties and to react more effectively to individual calls for emergency service. This system will enable the United States Postal Service to plan its postal routes with a permanent addressing system.

In addition the numbering system is linked with the enhanced 911 Emergency Dispatch located at the La Paz County Sheriff's Department, to increase the effectiveness of this system and to reduce response times by emergency vehicles.

Comprehensive Addressing and Emergency 911 system will assign a single permanent number for use as both a location identifier and a mailing address for all properties on the Colorado River Indian Reservation. The incorporated Towns of La Paz County, including The Town of Parker, Arizona which has existing house numbering systems will continue to use those systems.

In the near future the CRIT fire department personnel will be making home visit to physically update our system and check posted numbers, and completing a survey.

DISPLAYING ADDRESS NUMBERS

1. Please display your 911 address numbers: 3 ½ "high X 2" wide.
2. USE REFLECTIVE NUMBERS – so that they may also be seen at night.
3. If living on side road – post numbers so that it will be seen from the road, otherwise post numbers visible on home
4. Numbers should be plain block numerals, not script.
5. Numbers should be set on a background of contrasting color, preferably black on white, again reflective numbers are desirable.
6. Do not place numbers on utility poles, road sign posts, or anywhere within the road right-of-way.
7. Make sure numbers are not blocked by trees or shrubs.
 - If you **DO NOT** have a 911 number please submit a **REQUEST FORM**.
 - If you already (**know**) **HAVE** a 911 number please submit a **SURVEY FORM**.
